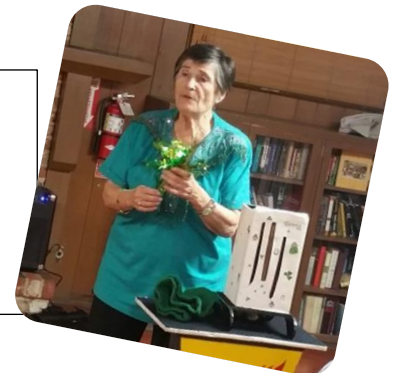
Ram told us about the Irish Mafia and how to magically detect their counterfeit quarters
