When nominating someone, please choose the "Reply All" with your nominations so that all the membership can see your nominations.


At our December meeting we will accept any last nominations and ask those who were nominated if they would like to accept the nomination.

OCMC President Julian started meeting, then passes it over to Vice-President Brad for some announcements.

Brad introduced our performers for tonight's Show & Tell.

Larry Campbell was up first for this month's Show & Tell,
Larry showed us 2 Bicycle decks of cards, one big and small sized deck.
Small and large. Choice, Which one? Joyce volunteered and choose the large deck
Once Joyce says the word, "GO", Larry folds the deck, crushes it, and it is gone, vanished and nowhere to be seen.
(David Regal Disposable Deck)
Larry says this is a great side effect when used as part of bigger routine.

Todd Reis is next up and was assisted by Julian—both Julian and Todd have decks of cards.
Julian names any card—Jack of Clubs.
Todd takes his deck out of box, the cards are very slippery and removes the Joker on Top.
Todd counts down 22 (11 x 2), and finds Jack of Clubs.
(ACAAN: Any card at any number).

Fernando Alvarez was the next to perform.

Fernando's hands can be seen on screen. Fernando explained that the Closed hand was Reality, and that the Open Hand is imagination.

Everyone is to imagine 3 coins in Fernando's open hand. Brad imagines that he grabs the dime. Then he imagines that he grabs the penny. That would leave Fernando with nickel

Brad puts coins in pocket. (We trust Brad on this, as this is all imagination).

Brad imagines that the nickel is heads up in Fernando's hand.

Fernando reveals that the Reality hand has nickel heads up.

Fernando was so confident; he had crossed out tails.

(Version of Max Maven's Positive/Negative)

I would also note here the power of positive thinking!

Joyce Basch is next.

Joyce shows everyone a Square pumpkin with cylinder inside.

Nothing up her sleeve.

Suddenly, Joyce produces autumn leaves from empty cylinder, nothing to hide, then without bones, Joyce pulls out a skeleton.

She again shows everyone an empty cylinder.

Tip from Joyce: Use Chiffon instead of Silk.


Chiffon frays; but does not wrinkle.

Ed requests volunteer with strong mental abilities to be able to pick up on things. Brad selects ME, Robert; obviously, Brad was aware of Robert's strong mental abilities.

He has 2 sets 5 special mentalists cards, the Square, the Plus, the Star, the Circle, the Wavy Lines



Ed sets out one set of the cards in a row and mixes the other set.

Robert picks one card to place under each one.

5 arranged, 5 mates arranged and they matched.

This was a very fun trick to watch.

Mel Bennett is up next.

Mel uses approximately half of deck for this trick.

He looks for Aces and removes them, then divides the rest of the deck into 4 piles of cards and sets one ace on top of each pile face down.

A virtual spectator lifts some cards from other pile and places on ace.

Then packets are assembled.

Now, Mel deals two piles., one face up and one face down. Alternating up and down.

One pile face up and one pile face down.

(James Parnell-3 cut principle)

After dealing two piles, discarding face up pile and repeat.

Mel is left with 3 aces.

--

Brad finishes up with Broke and Restored Rubber Band. The Blue broke, then with Red rubber band. Broke and back.
