Lecture

Guest Lecturer Hayden Allcorn gave an excellent lecture about magic and showmanship. He spoke about the importance of having fun on stage and how an audience is more likely to remember the great time they had over the ins and outs of how a trick works. He performed several tricks demonstrating different concepts. Nail in the nose showed the humor of an unpleasant act against the background of uplifting music. A spectator's loses his card into the deck and Hayden locates it; he later let us in on the fact he actually had made a mistake and had to go to plan B; thus, a magician must have a backup plan and have fun on stage. He ending with a demonstration of locating a card while in a strait jacket demonstrating the importance of fitting a trick to one's own personality. One trick, Paul selected a random card and it somehow found its way into a raw egg. That demonstrated the importance of always checking your eggs at the checkout counter.
