At our December meeting, the membership voted and passed to keep the same board for 2021.


There was one change, Brad nominated Phil for Treasurer, the nomination was seconded and the membership voted to confirm Phil as Treasurer.

Todd Reis had a card board ballot box on table and a big jumbo card with only it's back seen on an easel. Then Todd shuffles a standard size deck of cards, and cuts the deck in half Joy volunteers and chooses one half of the deck—Todd throws the selected half into the box. He repeats this and when the final card left, it is the 2 of clubs, the card on the easel is turned over to reveal that it also is the 2 of clubs. A perfect match.
