## OCMC's $5^{\text {th }}$ Online Meeting was a lot of fun.

Our Vice-President Brad Erickson took the helm starting us off making sure everyone was good to go with proper video and audio capability for this month's lecture. I appreciate Brad's use of the vernacular.

Todd Reis showed us some interesting effects, one where Todd takes a photograph of the Statue of liberty and then suddenly the Statue disappears.

He shared with us that he'd gotten those at Project Polaroid and the package came with a bunch of them

He also showed us a folded card effect, but in this effect, the folded card was on a picture and then suddenly folding card is in hand. Very strange.

Ken Klein showed us an effect with a 20-dollar bill, Ken folds the bill, places pencil right through the bill. Then cover with a piece of paper.

He taps the pencil down through the paper \& bill; yet, the paper is damaged; but, 20dollar bill is okay!

Adriana showed us a card trick where 4 coins under different cards suddenly end up under a single card. Great performance of The Metrix.

Mel performed a trick with an Outer Space type theme referencing our solar system. He had round cards with the planet's names on them

He then placed an object on the card representing the planet Neptune.
Volunteer Brad named a random planet to stop at on way home. Brad names Venus. Mel count to V-E-N-U-S and then lands on Saturn. Now Mel spells S-A-T-U-R-N and now we land back home on Earth.

Julian jumped in to volunteer and names the planet Jupiter, Mel spells J-U-P-I-T-E-R and then lands on MARS. Mel always end up landing on Earth no matter what planet is names.

I'm so glad no one named Pluto, then, we would need to have the obligated discussion on whether Pluto is still considered a planet. I think astronomers now reference Pluto as a "dwarf planet".

Ed used a clipboard and wrote prediction on paper. Adriana volunteered to answer a few questions. Ed placed 10 numbered cards on the table. Number side down.

As Ed moved his hand over the cards Adriana had steered Ed into selected 5 cards revealing the numbers 91620---Todays date picked by Adriana. That was a surprise.

WILDCAT JACKSON!!! joined by Levi.

Wildcat, Purveyor of the strange and the curious, takes an average nail. Levi confirms nail is real.

Wildcat then showed us all an interesting thing one can do with a nail.
Now Levi showed us a trick...Baby Yoda and special set of cards. After creating 2 piles. The $4^{\text {th }}$ card down on one pile tells what $4^{\text {th }}$ cards down on other side is with a little assistance from Mr. Yoda.

Joy was up next, and as we learned from last month's Spotlight on Joy, she likes mathematical magic.

For the zoom presentation, Joy took out the 3 aces as the chosen cards to represent the three participants from the audience.

Joy deals out 3 piles with the remaining cards, and then sets 5 cards to the side.
Then, with the three selected cards...
The 1st volunteer places his/her card on the first pile. (in this case, the ace) He can take any number of cards from the second pile to cover his card.

The 2nd volunteer places his card on the second pile. He too can take any number of cards from the third pile to cover his card.

The 3rd volunteer places his card on the third pile. Joy then covers his card with the five extra cards that were set aside earlier.

Now, Joy gathers up all the piles of cards and proceeds to deal down two piles: faceup and face-down.

Joy now claims that she will find the chosen cards before the participants do. The last 3 cards dealt were the chosen aces!

Joy let us know that the deck must have only 52 cards; otherwise, you may end up performing an entirely different trick!

Brad performed an interesting version of the card trick Out of the World. Joy assisted Brad dealing the cards into several piles with some shuffles interspersed.

Finally, cards in each pile are of the same color as top card and then cards under new color card match. Quite interesting.

Wild Cat gave us a preview into his upcoming lecture on character development.

Todd end the meeting with an interesting trick called ARTHUR, where he removes card and sticks into deck and you can lift the entire deck by that one card.
