

Members are encouraged to attend, buy a lunch, then session on tricks and/or talk about Magic.

Magic Sessions – Beginning in November, Harrison has volunteered to begin leading magic sessions prior to club meetings beginning at 6:45.

Harrison has been studying and performing magic for over 40 years and has known and had sessions with some of magic's heavyweights such as Charlie

Miller, Ed Marlo, Larry Jennings, Bruce Cervon, Dai Vernon, Stewart James and many others.

He has a ridiculously large library of magic. This enables him to be very selective in choosing the best and most practical material, which can save the learners time and confusion of finding which techniques work best for different effects.

Session topics will range from card and coin magic, to impromptu magic with everyday items (bottle caps, cigarette papers, dice, paper napkins, string, and corks, etc.). Most of the magic effects will be at the basic to immediate level.

These sessions are for magicians only. Harrison will guide session attendees in a focused and concentrated manner to maximize the magicians learning experience.

Attendees at the club's September meeting, know that Harrison possesses the chops to deliver a really solid learning experience. His performance with a deck of cards was simply flawless in both technique and presentation.

Sessions will begin as 6:45 and last to approximately 7:15 prior to the monthly club meeting.

Silent Auction – Any member can bring one magic item per month to be put in the Silent Auction. You can either donate the item to the club and the club keeps all the money or you keep 80% of the sale price while the club gets 20% of the sale price.

The Silent Auction is a win/win for both the club and the members. This is your chance to get rid of that magic trick that is just sitting in your closet collecting dust. Turn that prop, gimmick, book, DVD, or VHS into some cold hard cash so you can buy some more magic.

Contestant Rules:

- 1. Contestant **must be a paid member** in good standing
- 2. Contestant shall perform on the stage (no close up, or in front of stage)
- 3. **No fire** is to be used for any trick or effect.
- 4. Contestant is responsible for any table, cover, music, chairs that are needed.
- 5. **The act shall be 5 to 12 minutes in length**. Any act that exceeds 12 minutes will be penalized in the event of a tie with another act.
- 6. Contestant must have notified the contest chairperson their intention to compete prior to the cutoff date published in the OCMC newsletter.
- 7. Contestants will not be allowed to vote.
- 8. A contestant who previously won the Floyd Baldwin Contest may not repeat the same act.
- 9. The Three Judges will be scoring the performers in the Stage Contest with the following Ten Point System:
 - 1) Introduction
 - 2) Opening Trick
 - 3) Deportment
 - 4) Dress/Costume
 - 5) Material/Tricks
 - 6) Transition from trick to trick
 - 7) Character/ Acting
 - 8) Interaction with Audience
 - 9) Speech/Patter
 - 10) Closing Trick
- 10. The 1st place winner will have their name engraved on the club's perpetual Floyd Baldwin Trophy.
- 11. The OCMC President or delegate will announce the winner's and make the awards at the end of the evening.

Attention Members Who Shall Be in The October Stage Contest:

If you are doing a non-talking act set to music, then you will be responsible for bringing in your own playing equipment. To wit: Playing devices, the music, speakers, extension cords, etc.

You are also responsible for having some club member you know, to run the music for you during your act. Have all of this preparation done before coming to the October meeting. Don't expect some random member at the meeting to put everything together for you at the "last minute", just before you perform in the Stage Contest. If you're in the Stage Contest, that needs music to be played, then you are responsible that your needed music gets played. This includes having a club member you know, to watch over your music equipment, to make sure it isn't stolen.
