March Lecture



Harrison performed 'Revolving Aces', 'The Inseparable Four', and 'Ose's Addition.

My personal favorite, 'Revolving Aces, was among the effects presented. Harrison's gave some wonderful ideas on the 'clean-up' necessary the end of the routine in order to move seamlessly into another effect. Harrison quoted Mr. Lorayne to have said, "If you can't do it secretly, do it right in front of their faces!". I'm paraphrasing here, but, you get the idea.


