August's Lecture

OCMC Vice-President Brad Erickson gave a wonderful lecture on performing Magic for Children. People worry about keeping the children's attention for an entire show; Brad gives us some great advice on dealing with the short attention span of children-- Know what your audience (the children) are into. What are their

interests? Once you know their interests, you can employ some psychological principles to incorporate into your children's act to make it a success. Brad gave us some tried and tested principles to employ:

- 1. Intentionally be clumsy.
- 2. Verbal incongruity
- 3. Something that just doesn't go there.
- 4. Intentionally make things go wrong. (This empowers kids and makes them feel super smart)
- 5. Say funny words, say them in a funny way!

Brettso the Great gave us some excellent examples employing those principles from tonight's lecture, which included an excellent performance of a mentalism effect

using transportation boarding passes to exotic places. Brett, has the audience supply the information to create the storyline, the amount of \$\$\$ stolen, the time the traveler left, and other info. Getting the audience involved, piqued their interest and raised the energy in



the room. At that moment, Brett brings out a large



paper display pulled from a sealed envelope labeled Top Secret. The paper correctly shows that Brett had correctly predicted all the responses from the audience before the audience supplies the information—Incredible!

Ed Smith was up next and called

on a volunteer from the audience-The Great Bradini!, who required an additional volunteer from the audience (the was a 2-volunteer effect!). The Great Bradini asked Brett to name a card, this named card was to be found in an envelope held by Ed. A wonderful display of The Great Bradini's psychic abilities combined with Ed's coaching provided the audience with an excellent example of mentalism.

Mel really enjoyed Harrison's lecture last month on mentalism and spoke about some great mentalism moments in magic history to include Theodore Annemann's famous performance of catching of a live-fired bullet in his mouth. It was really cool to hear Mel describe the intensity of Corinda's performance of this effect: All the streets that went into the area of the effect were blocked off due to the live-ammunition used. If that doesn't raise anyone's blood-pressure, I do not know what would.

Mel shared some info about a book he's purchased when it first came out in 1968,13 Steps in Mentalism by Corinda, which has a chapter on book tests. Mel gave

us an example of the W.O.W. book test II (Walk-on-Water). The effect uses two books, Introduction to Resort Magic and Female Strategies. Mel has a member in the audience select one of the books – (Intro to Resort Magic) and select a page – pg. 116 selected. Mel has the



member mentally send the letters from a word from that page. Under seemingly impossible conditions, Mel is

able to name the word from the page in a book selected by the spectator. A truly wonderful effect.
